

Covid-19 information for guests from the United Kingdom

Entry from the UK

Since December 25, only triple vaccinated persons aged 12 years and older with a negative PCR test of max. 48 hours may enter Austria. Persons who have been vaccinated twice with the Janssen vaccine from Johnson & Johnson may also enter with a negative PCR test. School-age children (12 - 15 years) may enter Austria with the first negative PCR test of the so-called "Holiday Ninja Pass".

Check-in at the accommodation

2-G rule for those ages 12 and up (Geimpft - vaccinated, Genesen - recovered)

During the stay

2-G rule in almost all sectors. Exemption: The Holiday Ninja Pass for school-age children and young people (12 – 15 years) is treated as equivalent to a 2-G certificate. The requirement for the pass is continuous testing during the holiday.

Vaccinated: from the day of the second vaccination, proof of vaccination certificate (valid for 270 days).

Attention: From January 3rd people vaccinated with Janssen vaccine need a second dose for a valid vaccination certificate.

Recovered: certificate of segregation or medical confirmation (valid for 180 days)

FFP2 mask requirement in all publicly accessible indoor areas and outdoors, wherever the 2-metre distance to other persons cannot be maintained (i.e. in pedestrian zones or waiting areas).

Restaurants, bars & cafés, accommodation and leisure

2-G proof, guest registration in the gastronomy, FFP2 mask requirement indoors

Ski lifts & cable cars:

2-G proof, FFP2 mask requirement in closed and coverable gondolas or lifts

Public transportation, grocery stores, banks, petrol stations, pharmacies, post offices, ...

Return journey

If you do qualify as fully vaccinated for travel to England, you do not need to take a test before travel.

Children aged 17 and under are exempt from taking a test. Please inform yourself before your return journey about the [currently valid regulations](#).
